

COVID-19 POLICY STATEMENT

UPDATE 1ST JULY 2021

In addition to the below, I respectfully ask all class members to follow the rules below. This is for the safety of everyone in class, as well as our wonderful coaches who need to stay fit and well (and out of isolation so that they can work).

To those eligible for restriction-free travel:

- * if you travel off island, please stay away from classes for a period of 7 days from your return date.
- * if you have guests arriving AND they are staying at your house, please stay away from classes for a period of 7 days from their arrival date
- * if your child is identified as a contact of a positive case and is sent home from school/preschool as a result, please stay away from classes until they are accepted back into their educational setting
- * please do not bring additional guests along to watch the classes. I appreciate that visiting grandparents, aunties, uncles etc may like to watch, but for the time being I would like to keep attendees to a minimum.

Little Champs Guernsey acknowledges its responsibility to protect attendees from the spread of COVID-19, wherever practicably possible.

We closely monitor and follow the latest guidelines from the States of Guernsey to ensure our classes are run in as safe an environment as we can. These guidelines *do* change depending on which stage of lockdown recovery we are in at the time that classes resume.

This policy confirms that all Little Champs classes abide by the following COVID-19 prevention practices as a minimum standard:

- Parents and carers are notified, when registering, that they must not attend class if they are feeling unwell or are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Coaches must cancel classes, or arrange cover, if they are feeling unwell or are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19.
- All attendees and coaches are required to sanitise their hands on entry to the sports hall. Hand sanitiser is provided.
- All equipment used within classes is sanitised between classes.

In addition, and depending on the stage of lockdown recovery, we may also:

- Keep a track and trace list of contact phone numbers for every person in attendance in every class (these details will be held and destroyed in accordance with States of Guernsey requirements, and in line with our data protection policy).
- Limit the number of people attending with their child to 1 adult only.
- Rearrange the layout of the class to ensure social distancing between all attendees, where practicably possible.

Little Champs classes will be cancelled at very short notice if we are required to do so by the States of Guernsey. Class fees will not be refunded – they will simply be carried forward to when we are able to resume classes. All bookings remain valid.
